Rules and Regulations

1. Gate wristbands need to be purchased along with entry fees. For all exhibitors, family and friends. These can be purchased within at gate.
2. Entry fees and prize monies shall be started in show schedule.
3. The directors reserved the right to pay prizes as shown in this prize list on a percentage base in the event that the revenue of the society is not sufficient to enable the prizes to be paid in full, alternately, the society may increase prize money as t he directors see fit.
4. Should there be only one exhibitor in any class, the judge is to use his or her own discretion as to awarding of a prize. The Society reserves the right to double up the classes in which there is only one exhibitor, or to pay out only 50 per cent of t he prize monies.
5. No entry fee shall be refunded for any no shows, scratches or injury unless a note from a licensed Doctor or Veterinarian is produced.
6. Age categories as of Jan 1st.
 - a. Mini 8yrs and under,
 - b. PeeWee 12 years and under,
 - c. Junior 18 years and under
 - d. Senior 19 years and over.
7. Equine height and age regulations.
 - a. Pony height shall be under 14.2 hands.
 - b. Light horse height shall be 14.2hands and over.
 - c. The show age of an equine is determined for January 1st preceding its birthday.

- d. No cross entry from light horse to pony unless otherwise stated in class description.
 - e. All ponies and horses are to be entered in one halter class per animal.
- 8. MGRA classes will follow the Manitoba Gymkhana Rodeo Association rules.
- 9. The same horse can be ridden by a Pee Wee, Junior and Senior in barrel racing for example, but the same horse cannot be ridden twice in the same age category.
- 10. No cross entry for horse rider combo between walk trot classes to the peewee, junior, senior classes.
- 11. Each horse shown must be a bona fide property of Exhibitor 30 days prior to show. Another rider or handler on behalf of exhibitor may show the horse. Prize monies will be paid to exhibitor only.
- 12. Stalls shall be allotted as director sees fit. Name tags or maps we placed on stalls/barns by 8:00 PM Wednesday night. No horses shall be on the grounds prior to this without the consent of directors.
- 13. Only horses being shown at the fair may be stalled at the grounds.
- 14. A stall fee of \$10 per horse will be charged. This is non-refundable and stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving.
- 15. All exhibitors must at all times cooperate with the fair officials in parking of trucks and trailers, properly parking wagons and buggies, and in keeping their stalls in an orderly and tidy condition.
- 16. Each horse brought to the grounds must be provided with some means of secure fastening. Every horse must be haltered and under control by the handler when out of the stable. All foals must be on a halter and lead outside their stall and during the parade. No loose foals in alleyways will be tolerated for safety reasons.
- 17. No animal may leave the grounds before 2:00 PM on Saturday unless the Light Horse directors grant permission.
- 18. The show directors reserved the right to test any medications, drug or mechanical devices administered internally or externally to a horse before or during any event and upon discovery of such, have the right to disqualify that horse from competing. The show directors also reserved the right to disqualify any horse they deem unhealthy or unsound.
- 19. Coggins Testing is not mandatory, but it is recommended that each horse be tested.
- 20. The judge and director in charge of light horse shall have the authority to measure any horse or pony if deemed necessary.
- 21. No person shall be permitted to enter the judging ring during the time of judging except the judge and his or her assistant, person in charge of animals, directors of society.
- 22. No person will be allowed to interfere with the judge
- 23. When exhibitors are not satisfied with the ruling of the judge, a protest in writing must be signed and handed to the secretary before the close of the fair, accompanying by a deposit of \$5.00, of which some will be forfeited to the society if said protest is not sustained.
- 24. All exhibitors and competitors should be neatly and appropriately dressed before entering the showing and correct back numbers must be worn during classes.
- 25. Exhibitors are asked to refrain from foul and abusive language in and around the stables and show ring profanity and abusive towards the judge or directors of the society will not be tolerated, and exhibitors or spectators will be asked to leave the area or fairgrounds entirely.
- 26. While directors take every precaution possible to ensure the safety of the articles placed of exhibitors. The owners must take upon themselves whole risk should any article or animal be injured, lost or stolen, while the directors will give every assistance in their power to the restoration. Therefore, they are not liable to make payment for the value of any articles or animals.
- 27. The Gilbert Plains Grandview Ag Society is not by law responsible to any one exhibitor or spectator for the loss, damage or injury that may occur to person by any animal or article or thing on the premise of the fair, the directors will of course take reasonable precautions to protect all persons and property on the premises.
- 28. No claim for injury to any person or property shall ever be asserted nor suit instituted or maintained against the Society, its officers or their agents by or on behalf of any visitor or any person, firm or corporation or their agents, representatives, servants or employees having license or privilege to exhibit on their fair premises or occupying any space thereon.
- 29. No tickets of any type shall be sold on the grounds on either fair day without obtaining written permission from the Society.
- 30. Should at any time any exhibitor not maintain control of their animal during the event or act in an unsafe manner, they will be asked to leave the ring at the director's or judges discretion.
- 31. There will be a \$20 weekend camping charge for campers on the fairgrounds. This is for everyone, including exhibitors. There will be a designated director directing where to park. If you cannot find the designated director, please call or text 204 -648-4254.
